

Dear loving Fathers and Brothers in Christ,

"This is what the eyes of consecrated men and women behold: the grace of God poured into their hands. we did not deserve religious life; it is a gift of love that we have received."

-(Pope Francis)

We celebrated the day of consecrated on February 2, 2021 on the solemnity of the presentation of the Lord. This is a day which seeks to support religious women and men in their calling to

radical discipleship to be – with a profound humility – a light for the world.

Religious life is a gift poured into the hands of all those who are called into it, like the Simeon received child Jesus in his hand. (Luke 2: 28). The "righteous and devout" (Luke 2:25) Simeon could say "My eyes have seen your salvation" (Lk 2:30). He saw in the child, "the Lord's Christ". Simeon sets an example for a true consecrated person. A consecrated is someone who could receive the gift of "religious life" and see in it the "way of salvation" which is of "the Lord's Christ".

The way of life of consecrated religious springs from the very heart of the gospel. It takes many forms in the way of Chrism which is expressed in various ministries which also embody the Lord's own way of life. One of Christ way of life is the life of poverty.

Jesus Christ is the teacher and model of poverty. The whole life of Jesus is a concretization of the virtue of poverty. "Though He was in the form of God, He did not regard equality with God" (Philippians 2:6.), but He allowed Himself to be carried in the womb of the Virgin Mary for nine months, "emptied Himself and took the form of a slave coming in human likeness" (Philippians 2:7) Jesus made Himself poor to make us rich through His poverty."

Mary is the first and foremost among the poor of Yahweh. "She stands out among the poor and humble of the Lord, who confidently awaits and receives salvation from Him." Mary represents the poor, subject, humble, and humiliated Israel, who hoped for all things from the powerful intervention of Yahweh. Mary, in her magnificat, knows and confesses that she has God on her side.

At La Salette witnesses the children, "she (Mary) was dressed like women of the region with a long dress, an apron nearly as long as the dress, a shawl that crossed over her breast and was knotted in the back, and a cap or bonnet similar to the ones worn by peasant women." She wore a dress of peasant woman. In a way she identified her with the people of the area.

The clothes have lot to talk about our way of life especially in this era of brands and expensive trademarks. A religious through their humble clothing conveys the way of life one aspires.

Because clothing is one of the primary vehicles that human beings use to attract attention, assert power, flaunt prestige, and indicate status, the religious habit has been connected, since the beginnings of consecrated life, with both exterior poverty in fact and interior poverty in spirit. The religious habit has been both a means to and an expression of the "spirit of detachment" from material things and the "spirit of attachment" to God.

For La Salette a habit is an expression of the virtue of poverty one professes. "In our apostolate we follow the example of the handmaid of the Lord who was made reconciler particularly at the foot of the cross" (Rule of life 5) Through their habit a La Salette Religious, "desiring to be poor like Christ and in the tradition of the Apostles who left everything to follow him, we aspire to attain a spirt of evangelical detachment." (Rule of life 10) Let us live our virtue of poverty following the example of our Lady of La Salette and Christ "the rule of our Life".

have planted 2000 areca saplings last year and coming up better.


