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Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life." (John 14:6)

Dear Fathers and brothers.

On 3rd of July, we celebrate the feast of St. Thomas, the Apostle. The Catholic Church in India invariably traces its origin to the preaching and martyrdom of St Thomas the Apostle, who, according to tradition, came to India in 52 A.D. nearly 2000 years ago. Beyond doubt, our faith lineage is rooted in Jesus Christ through a person who lived and shared his life with Him. Thomas the Apostle, who among the apostles travelled far to a country, landed in India and in those circumstances sowed the seeds of Gospel and reaped the harvest with baptismal consecration to Christ. History proves undoubtedly that he founded several communities of Christian faith in our country. We are the inheritors of this greatest treasure. The Gospel records three interventions made by Thomas, that shares with us abundance of his faith in Christ.

I would like to reflect with you the intervention he had with Jesus during last supper.

On that occasion, predicting his own imminent departure, Jesus announced that he was going to prepare a place for his disciples so that they could be where he is found; and he explains to them: 'Where [I] am going you know the way" (Jn 14:4). It is, then that Thomas intervenes, saying: "Lord, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?" (Jn 14:5). In fact, with this remark he places himself at a rather low level of understanding; but his words pave a clear path for Jesus with the opportunity to state his famous definition: "I am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life" (Jn 14:6). "Thus, it is primarily to Thomas that he makes this revelation, but it is valid for all of us and for every age. Every time we hear or read these words, we can stand beside Thomas in spirit and imagine that the Lord is also speaking to us, just as he spoke to him." (Pope Benedict XVI). In short, the revelation, "I am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life" shows us that every moment of suspicion in faith can lead us to sovereign truth and higher certainty.

The concept of truth is elusive and unanswered, as seen in the plot of the trial of Jesus by Pilate who asked, "What is truth?" (In 3:18), in this present world because we fail to search for the pearls of faith in the field. We are happy in our comfort zones with minimal outcomes. Restricting ourselves in our tiny cocoons and shells and being satisfied with old revelations will limit us the way of new revelations and new arena of truths. To its core, the world seeks answers and solutions and we need to respond like Apostle Thomas who pioneered the disciple community to find answers to their question. Thomas who found true "way" in Jesus, voyaged longest way to share his faith. He experienced the kernel of "truth, that sets all free" (Jn8:31) in Jesus by insisting to see the transformed wounds of Jesus, declared the greatest truth ever, "My Lord and My God". St. Thomas dared to stand with Jesus; losing his "life" found in his martyrdom the real "life", winning life in

As disciples of Christ, more especially as his followers as religious priests, we should live and lead by example to pause questions of faith and find answers to satisfy our deepest questions and Thomas' example will never fail to strengthen our faith in Jesus Christ, Our Lord and Our God.
