The month of November reminds us that "each of us is a unique person fashioned by a loving creator who are but part of larger communion of persons stretching back (and forth) in time". Remaining in gratitude to those memories of the past enlighten us how indebted we are to several people. We live the faith they have initiated in us. We live the values they taught us and lived by example. All the more it is their hard work and toil that helped us to grow.

These are emotions which would rule our heart as we dedicate the whole month for praying for our loved ones who went ahead of us to share the life in Christ.

I was just four years old when I first mentioned to my Mother that I want to become a priest. I already had special love towards baby Jesus in the crib, special love for the statue of Mary in the church and looked at the Monstrance with awe and wonder at adoration, during those years.



They were self-prompted... Nobody instructed me to do so. I also liked our parish priest as a friend those days.

It continued till I was in 10th standard. That time my parish priest was very unfriendly and un approachable guy. So I started to drift away from my faith and closeness towards church.

During my second year degree course my best friend expressed his wish to become a priest and slowly my feelings towards priesthood was rekindled in my heart and upon graduation from college I had but one desire that is to be religious as I was inspired by my uncle who was a Franciscan Brother and I joined his community.

There in the Franciscan community after three months in Postulancy, I was promoted to the novitiate. Although I was very happy in the novitiate a few things weren't right so I had to leave and stop my formation with them.

After five months out of Franciscan formation I heard about Fr. Jos Kuzhinjalil who was in the Philippines and I wrote him. He in turn gave my letter to Fr. Efren Musngi who met me at Ernakulam and accepted me to start my formation to be a La Salette in the Philippines.

Though I was only one year and three months with the Franciscan Brothers, without me realizing it, my religious life formation was already done with them because I loved them and I was so happy while I was with them. This community is a religious brothers' community and God wants me to be Priest so this transition was essential.

I arrived in bPhilippines on August 23rd 1981 and I must say if I didn't have the Franciscan formation I would not have survived in La Salette because of the culture of Philippines.

I got ordained as a Priest on 23rd February 1991. God definitely has a plan for each and every one and that is the only one plan that will come true in our lives. So here I am a La Salette Missionary priest for the past 28 years.

I am Ajin Mathew Kuttiyanickal, hailing from Ezhukumvayal, Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parish, Iddukki, Kerala. My father's name is Mathew Joseph and mother is Jessy Mathew.
