## I WISH YOU A HAPPY AND BLESSED EASTER.

Yet again we celebrate Easter, amidst doom of Corona Pandemic. Even after one year of difficulties caused by this pandemic, it shows no decline. Many of the countries report of second or third wave. The governments are forced to make strict measures affecting the normal life of the people. One of it is the faith life. People are compled especially the sick and elderly to remain in their house out of fear of this sickness. As religious and as priests we have that great responsibility to reach to the people with the message of Easter.

The Lord appeared to His disciples after His resurrection and greeted them, saying, "Peace be to you." Many times in sacred scripture our blessed Lord offers his peace. So it is in our lives, the Lord Jesus stands in our midst and says, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid." (John 14:27)

As we prepare to celebrate Easter, one might ask if this is the appropriate time in the midst of this global fear to proclaim the Good News that Jesus Christ is risen. Those who first witnessed the resurrection offer a response which is timely. To the women who came to his tomb with fear he offered peace. "Do not be afraid; go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me." (Mat 28:10).

Jesus assures us not to be afraid. The fear of death, sickness and suffering should be replaced with the inner peace offered by resurrected Jesus. He invites us not to look the resurrected among the dead. Jesus is risen! This is the great message of Easter. The light of Easter is reaching to us to transform us and to strengthen us. We experience this in the Easter liturgy, when the darkened Church is lighted up with the light of Easter candle, the symbol of resurrected Christ.

At La Salette, Blessed Virgin Mary too uttered these words, "do not be afraid...". She came in light as an expression of resurrected Jesus to cast away the deeds of darkness. At first, she casts away the darkness of fear from the children. They are invited to the love of mother. Their darkness of ignorance is removed through the proclamation of the word of God by beautiful lady. They testified, "she spoke of our life". She invited them to Jesus who is crucified. The cross was 'brightening with light", a symbolism of Jesus who died for us to cast away the darkness of sin.

Faith is like a bright ray of sunlight. It enables us to see God in all things as well as all things in God." (St. Francis de Sales) Mary was inviting the children to this bright light of Christ. It was a transfiguration experience for the children like the disciple who experienced it in the presence of Jesus at mount Tabor. They went down the valley of mount Alps to share this joy and witness La Salette.

As an Easter people, let us proclaim the Resurrected Christ knowing that He has brought forth life from death, light from darkness, and hope from despair. As Saint John Paul II says, "Do not abandon yourselves to despair. We are the Easter people and hallelujah is our song.'

This Easter, in these unusual times, let us find within our faith the sustenance and resolve to proclaim, "He is risen." And we rejoice saying, "Alleluia. Alleluia. Alleluia." May God bless you with abundant faith, serenity and joy this Easter.

needs of community. We greatly acknowledge and thank the contribution from Fr. Joby Kadambattuparamil MS to make our life more active through his kind heart to support for us in it.


