

When Joseph awoke he did as the angel of the Lord had directed him. (Mat 1: 24) Dear Fathers and brothers,

First of all, I wish God's grace and blessings up on all of you who celebrate the anniversary of your profession on 1st of May. I specially greet Fr. Baiju Avittappally MS, Fr. Biju Chempottickal MS, Fr. Rojan Cheriyadan MS, Fr. Joseph Peethuruthel MS, and Fr. Joy Porathur MS who beginthe Silver Jubilee year of their profession. My prayerful greetings to Fr. Johnny Vadakkan Fr. Jose Muttathan MS and Fr. James Kalliath MS who complete the year of silver Jubilee. I thank all of them for their committed service to the community.

Every year 1st of May we observe as the day of workers and we venerate the St. Joseph the worker. To foster deep devotion to Saint Joseph among Catholics, and in response to the "May Day" celebrations for workers sponsored by Communists, Pope Pius XII instituted the feast of Saint Joseph the Worker in 1955. St. Joseph places before us the model of life patterned after hard work and obedience to the will of God.

It is very little written in the Gospel about St. Joseph. In silent spirituality he speaks the whole of Gospel and its values. The Gospel presents himself as an upright man, a man of principle. We also know that Joseph had dreams. God spoke to him in his dreams and he followed his dreams. Joseph is a man of action: he does what the angel tells him; he takes Mary as his wife; he goes to Bethlehem; he finds a place to stay for the night; he takes his family to Egypt. He's a man of action- not a man of words.

Beginning in the Book of Genesis, the dignity of human work has long been celebrated as a participation in the creative work of God. By work, humankind both fulfils the command found in Genesis to care for the earth (Gn 2:15) and to be productive in their labours. Saint Joseph, the carpenter and foster father of Jesus, is but one example of the holiness of human labour.

Saint Joseph is held up as a model of such work. Pius XII emphasized this when he said, "The spirit flows to you and to all men from the heart of the God-man, Saviour of the world, but certainly, no worker was ever more completely and profoundly penetrated by it than the foster father of Jesus, who lived with Him in closest intimacy and community of family life and work."

At La Salette blessed mother emphasised the dignity and value of work. She told the children to labour by "not swearing in God's name", keeping the day of the Lord holy, through conversion harvesting the richness of labour, by observing the changes in the field and in the crops, recognising it as God's call... She was calling her children to the dignity of work.

She wore the clothes of a working peasant woman of the Alpine village. Through this she identified herself with the people of the area. She spoke their language. She spoke about their agriculture. Like St. Joseph, Mary was a woman of action through her words.

It is to these poor children, who were working for their family or being hired for work that Mary disclosed the mysteries of reconciliation and rewards of conversion. She was reminding the chil-

dren the fruits of reconciliation are first visible in the fields of their labour. She said "if her people obeyed, the very stones would become mounds of wheat in the fields, and potatoes would be self-sown in the fields".

Her message and mission still have the power to renew and reconcile us back to God. They help stir up within us the believe that, through the power of faith in her Son, we can do the works Jesus did and, as he once proclaimed, even "do greater ones than (he did)" (John 14:12).


Preparatory Exams: In the month of April preparatory exams were conducted in La Salette Vidya Nikethan for both school and PUC students.



Happy Days: On 23rd of April, Scho. Nikhil has gone to Parakkadavu for the PPP programme. Community wished him all the best for his future accomplishments.








Easter Celebrations: The Niketan community celebrated Easter with Covid restrictions.
