Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe. (John 19: 27) Dear Fathers and Brothers in Christ,

On July 3rd the church in India celebrates the Solemnity of St. Thomas, the Apostle to India. The Indian church is proud of its rich heritage handed down by Apostle Thomas. We the Christians of India keep burning the light of faith proclaimed by Apostle Thomas.

It is an opportune time to reflect on our witnessing of faith we have in Christ. Apostle Thomas challenges us with his approach to Jesus and his gospel. He was courageous that he was ready to die with Jesus. He then said to the disciple to go with Jesus to Jerusalem even if they have to face death. "Let us also go, that we may die with him." (John 11: 16). St. Thomas teaches us about the consequences of faith. Faith is meant to be lived. We are called to stake our life on what he reveals to us, to become a martyr, a witness, to what he reveals. He was willing to die for Jesus who was going to die in a week for him. That's where faith leads. A faith that doesn't trust in the Lord, in his promise of resurrection, in his teaching us the way to live and die enough to stake our life on his resurrection and ours, really isn't worthy of the description "faith."

He was eager and curious to learn from Jesus. During the Last Supper when Jesus was talking about his needing to go away but then come back again. Jesus stated, "Where I am going, you know the way." That's when Thomas, who had the guts to say what others were thinking but were perhaps too timid to ask, blurted out, "Lord, we do not know where you are going, how can we know the way?" Blessed John Henry Cardinal Newman once said that a thousand questions don't constitute a single doubt.

The third encounter of Apostle Thomas mentioned in the gospel is the post resurrection narrative. It is where I call your attention. Jesus calls Thomas near to his wounded heart. Jesus wanted to show to Thomas the depth of his love. In a closeness which is between them, Thomas proclaims "My lord and My God". Faith experience demands closeness to God and closeness to Jesus. Being away from the community of disciples, Thomas lacked "Jesus experience". He was compelling that he wanted to be so close to Jesus that not a third person can move between them. In our relationship with, we need this attitude of Thomas. We see the wounds of love more clearly when we are close to Jesus.

At La Salette, the children testified that, between them and blessed mother "not a third person could pass". They were so close to blessed mother. Indeed, blessed mother stood so close to them. It is this proximity of mothers love helped them to listen to her words and to go deep into the globe of fire. They were surrounded by the same light which engulfed blessed mother. The children viewed mother in a different perspective. They obtained the radiance of love of blessed mother.

The God experience of St. Thomas and the experience of children at La Salette with Blessed

Mother tells us about a great message: between us and God there should not be anything that hinder us to experience the love of God and listen to his words. Anything that separate us should be removed. Our deep desire to experience his wounds, our readiness to stand close to God and his Gospel opens the treasures of faith. It gives us a strong courage to witness Christ and his love. Let us be carriers of Gospel, by being close to God and proclaiming, "My Lord and My God".
