Dear loving Fathers and Brothers,

First of all I wish you all special blessings for this month of September. Especially as we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of La Salette, I extend to you all the joys of a blessed feast celebration. This year is so special to us. We celebrate the 175th anniversary of the Apparition of Our Lady of La Salette. As we have described it in our Jubilee Logo, "175 years of Grace", it is indeed true that the apparition is a "grace" for the whole world. We have been preparing this whole year to celebrate this Year of Grace. We inaugurated the Jubilee Year, by lighting the Jubilee Lamp by His Excellency Mar Pauly Kannookadan, the Bishop of Irinjalakuda. Later on, 19th September 2020, we lit the Jubilee Candle in our respective communities. We received the pilgrim statue of our Lady of La Salette in our communities. It was a moment of grace.

We have been meditating on different jubilee theme. We organized recollection materials for our members, seminarians and laity. We have prepared "La Salette Mathavinte Vanakamasam", a special prayer book in Malayalam which is to be recited the whole month of September.

Our all efforts were responding to the mandatory words of the blessed mother, "make this known to all my people". All this celebration leads us to a life based on this message. A life based on prayer, penance and zeal. Blessed mother exhorts us to a life of reconciliation. Through her message he invites us, "come near my children.." she says. She invites us to hear the great news. Her invitation is to be received setting aside our worries and fear. She means do not obey me merely through fear and not even by virtue, if I may dare say so, but be for my Son and for myself like children full of confidence, entirely offered. Be like faithful friends who live with him in perpetual commune, following his words, not merely by refraining from disobeying him but also by nourishing and fortifying self with the sustaining and vivifying words, like faithful friends, assiduous and joyful, true children of Mary indeed—not timid servants who are always standing in the background.

Blessed mother pleads to us. "If my people will not submit, I shall be forced to let go the arm of my Son. It is so strong, so heavy, that I can no longer withhold it. If I would not have my Son abandon you, I am compelled to pray to him without ceasing". This pleading is to submit ourselves to Christ in "love and obedience".

Through her message, the Blessed Mother warns us. "Six days have I given you to labor, the seventh I have kept for myself, and they will not give it to me. It is this which makes the arm of my Son so heavy!" The disobedience to God and to his commandments, she warns "makes the arm of her Son so heavy".

Blessed Mother reproaches us. Mary then reproaches her people with profaning the name of God. "Those who drive the carts cannot swear without introducing the name of my Son. These are the two things which make the arm of my Son so heavy." She asks like a mother with so much love and tenderness, "my children, do you say your prayers well?". It expresses the concern of a loving mother. She enquires about our spiritual life. These words we have heard from our mothers. They are always concerned about our spiritual life.

Finally, she says, "make this known to all my people". It is a fact that all who go to La Salette and breath in the atmosphere full of "grace" become unexpectedly possessed with a desire for greater intimacy with God, with a longing for silence and prayerful reflection because, casting themselves at the feet of "she who weeps", they have found the "Mother of beautiful love." May Our Lady of La Salette intercede for us.
