Dear Fathers and Brothers,

A yearlong intense living and meditating of La Salette Spirituality came to an end at the conclusion of Jubilee year of 175th anniversary of the apparition of Our Laday at La Salette. This year of grace we celebrated and observed as Marian year. Many are the blessings we received through this Jubilee year. LA SALETTE ASHRAM, WAYANAD



Environmental Day: As part of the environmental day, we have planted a tree in our school campus in order to care and nurture our mother earth.


Exams: The FA1 exams were conducted for
