

## Reflection

Why do I insist on speaking twice as much as I listen? One mouth and two ears should tell me other-wise. Mary always speaks words that I can understand, if only I could listen: but the worldly noises push out the words of life and hope and so as a poor beggar I cry out: Lord, that I may hear!

There is mystery in gift of roses. Their scent goes directly to the heart and recalls loving gestures long past: How long a time do I suffer for you! Mary's participation in the mystery of her Son began with a fiat and ended with a crown in heaven. Can my gift of self be as constant and total?
